<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 12 elementary school students with trained volunteer tutors to help with reading and math.</li> <li>• 10 children with bilingual beginning-to-read books to build early literacy skills</li> <li>• Three 30-minute appointments for health assessment and counseling for individuals facing physical, developmental or mental health challenges.</li> <li>• 1 acre of unprotected tropical rainforest which assures protection of the natural areas vital to our climate and diverse species.</li> <li>• 1 hour of expert training for a citizen's group interested in preserving natural areas in their communities</li> </ul> <p><b>That's \$52 a year . . .</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two months of meals for a homebound person.</li> <li>• Five wigs for children with cancer undergoing chemotherapy.</li> <li>• Two nights of shelter for a troubled or neglected youth.</li> <li>• After school care (food, health, recreation, and homework help) for one child for a year.</li> <li>• Clothing, shoes and a winter coat for one individual who has lost everything in a home fire.</li> <li>• Temporary shelter for a family of four for three nights following a disaster, or shelter for 10 people for one night.</li> <li>• Three bowling trips for seniors.</li> <li>• Gas or power service for an elderly or disabled person who has been threatened with a utilities termination notice.</li> </ul> <p><b>That's \$ 260 a year . . .</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two days of care for a terminally ill individual.</li> <li>• Baby formula for 52 low-income infants (one each week).</li> <li>• A full year of scouting for two girls.</li> <li>• Five and a half weeks of work training.</li> <li>• One month of preschool for a child at risk of falling through the cracks.</li> <li>• Funding for daily radio legislative updates, during the legislative session and monthly for interim committees.</li> <li>• Lightweight wheelchair for a person who is physically challenged.</li> <li>• Posters and other educational materials to inform national park visitors about steps they can take to help prevent increased air pollution in their parks</li> <li>• Allows five people being treated for mental illness to attend recovery classes that provide education, peer support, and healing strategies.</li> </ul> <p><b>That's \$520 a year . . .</b></p>
